

End User License Agreement (“EULA”)

By purchasing, downloading or running this software, you agree to be bound by this license agreement. If you do not agree with any of these terms, you are not allowed to use this software and must uninstall and stop using the software immediately.

Usage

This agreement allows you to:

- Download current and future versions of the software (previous versions may be also provided if possible).
- Use the software on an indefinite number of Spigot servers as long as you own each of these servers.
- Create new content and share it (as long as it does not violate other terms) such as configuration files, screenshots, videos.

You must not:

- Redistribute the software in any form with anyone else (this includes the provided binary, any part of its source code etc.)

unless we specifically allow it.

The source code is not a part of the agreement and will not be provided.

Your rights to use the software may be revoked under the terms described in the “Termination” paragraph.

Compatibility

This software is designed for Spigot server software only. It most likely will work with other server software, but we may refuse to give support for any setups based on other server software, if we cannot reproduce your issue on Spigot.

Updates

We are not obliged to provide any updates, bug fixes or feature additions. However, we will do our best to improve the software, by providing the former, especially bug fixes.

Termination

We can terminate this EULA if you breach any part of the terms. Additionally, due to how the resources marketplace works, the EULA is terminated as soon as you open a dispute or initiate a chargeback. This also results in your access to the resource being removed immediately. You can also terminate it, by uninstalling the purchased software. If this EULA is terminated you will no longer possess any of the rights to use the software being the subject of this agreement.
